RED LOTUS • ASIAN FILM FESTIVAL VIENNA 2025: A Celebration of Visionary Cinema and Cultural Exchange

From April 24 to 27, 2025, **RED LOTUS • ASIAN FILM FESTIVAL VIENNA** is returning to Stadtkino and Gartenbaukino, presenting an exquisite selection of 14 outstanding films that redefine cinematic artistry, narrative depth, and social relevance. The festival once again provides an important platform for the diverse voices of Asian cinema, showcasing works that captivate with their visual power, narrative sophistication, and thematic boldness.

A Focus on Feminist Narratives

With its expertly curated selection, this year's festival highlights not only the stylistic and thematic breadth of Asian cinema but also its commitment to artistic innovation and social discourse. Among the featured works are poignant feminist narratives that challenge conventions and redefine perspectives on gender and empowerment.

Opening Film: *Village Rockstars 2*Rima Das (IND, SGP, CHN | 2024 | 108 min | OmeU)

Acclaimed filmmaker Rima Das presents *Village Rockstars 2*, a mesmerizing continuation of her cinematic exploration of resilience and dreams. Set in a remote Indian village, the film follows a young girl's unwavering pursuit of her passion for music despite societal and familial constraints. Winner of the prestigious Kim Jiseok Award at the Busan International Film Festival, this Austrian premiere is a testament to the enduring power of self-determination and artistic ambition.

Closing Film: *Don't Cry, Butterfly*Dương Diêu Linh (VNM, SGP, PHL, IDN | 2024 | 97 min | OmeU)

Vietnamese director Dương Diệu Linh crafts a richly layered genre-bending tale that intertwines traditional beliefs with contemporary feminist discourse. **Don't Cry, Butterfly** explores a woman's unconventional journey to liberation from patriarchal constraints, rendered through a visually compelling, symbol-laden aesthetic that dissolves the boundaries between reality and mysticism.

Spotlight on Hong Kong: Cinema as a Reflection of Social Transformation

Again this year, with the support of the Hong Kong Economic and Trade Office Berlin (HKETO), the festival places a special emphasis on Hong Kong's dynamic production landscape. Among the highlights is *The Way We Talk* by Adam Wong, an evocative drama that examines identity, language barriers, and the political undercurrents of a city in flux. By blending documentary elements with fictional storytelling, Wong crafts a profound meditation on communication, belonging, and social inclusion.

Honoring Legends & Pioneering Traditions

The *LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD 2025* recognizes the pioneering work of the **Shanghai Animation Film Studio**, an institution that has shaped the aesthetics of Chinese animation since the 1950s. Renowned for its masterful fusion of traditional ink painting and paper-cut animation with contemporary techniques, the studio will present the Austrian premiere of *A Story about Fire*, offering a glimpse into its groundbreaking artistic legacy.
